Date	Subject
<b>Monday 8<sup>th</sup> May</b>	English - Reading Test 60 minutes
<b>Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> May</b>	English - Grammar, Punctuation & Spelling Test (40 mins)
<b>Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> May</b>	Maths Test - Arithmetic Paper 1 (30 mins) Maths - Mathematics Reasoning Paper 2 (45 mins)
<b>Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> May</b>	Maths - Mathematics Reasoning Paper 3 (45 mins)

All Children will need to be in school by **8.40am**. The tests will begin at a specific time so please make sure your children:

- Arrive on time
- Have had a healthy and nutritious breakfast e.g. cereals, fruits, yoghurts, milk or juice.
- Have had plenty of sleep- Research says the more sleep a child gets, the better their attainment at school.
